Jaguar's Racing History

The Roaring Beginnings

It all started in the late 1930s when Jaguar, then known as SS Cars, decided to take its sleek and stylish cars onto the racetrack. The legendary SS 100 was a standout, and it quickly made a name for itself in events like the Mille Miglia. But World War II put the brakes on their racing ambitions—until the 1950s revved up!

The Golden Era

Enter the 1950s, a decade that would see Jaguar truly roar! The iconic XK120 and the C-Type raced into the spotlight, dominating the prestigious Le Mans 24 Hours race. In 1951, Jaguar clinched its first Le Mans victory, with the C-Type zooming past the competition. Their success continued with the D-Type, which not only captured hearts with its stunning looks but also won Le Mans three times in a row from 1955 to 1957. Talk about a winning streak!




